

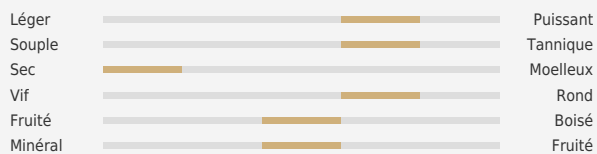


MASINTIN "CARIGNAN"

PRODUIT

Truquilemu is one of the coolest areas of the Maule Valley, hidden by the surrounding hills. It is cultivated by only a few small winemakers, including Waldo Orellana, who cultivates his 70-plus-year-old goblet vines without irrigation by hand and on horseback. This wine is fermented with indigenous yeasts and aged in concrete vats, cocchiopesto amphorae, and old French oak barrels. This Carignan is a pure expression of the grape variety. Vinified with great delicacy, it is full of red fruits and spices. The palate is full-bodied and dense with a tangy finish and a beautiful acidity that lends the wine length.
