

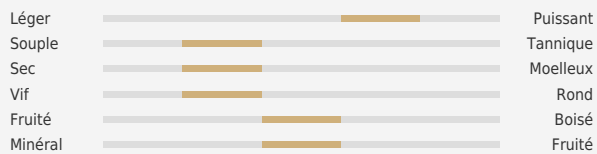


CHATEAU D'ARLAY - GRAND VIN JAUNE

PRODUIT

A dry and powerful wine with oxidative aromas of nuts, obtained from the local Savagnin grape variety, our Vin Jaune is made from old vines from the 1950s with low yields and aged for nearly 7 years in oak barrels without topping up – an operation usually consisting of compensating for the share of the angels in the barrel by regularly topping up the wine's level. It is this absence of topping up that reveals a veil of characteristic natural yeasts, giving the wine a unique flavor of nuts (walnuts) and tender spices.
